Our Beginnings

Any understanding of the origins of Camps Airy & Louise will find its first sparks in Ida (Miss Ida) Sharagrodsky's founding vision of a sun-filled mountain retreat for young Jewish immigrant women (and soon after would come their male counterparts) seeking a brief respite from the challenging conditions of a week-in, week-out work life in the city of Baltimore. A social worker with the Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society, Miss Ida had a clear understanding of why such an effort was necessary. But the camps would never have found a permanent place in the hearts of thousands and thousands of young people over the generations without the benevolent gifts of Aaron and Lillie Straus and their genius for knowing how, what and where to convert a fantasy into a reality.

Commitment to Camperships

From its inception in 1922, our institutional visionaries shared an ambition that Camps Airy & Louise would be available to children, including those without sufficient financial resources, who wished to enrich their lives through participation in Jewish camping. Subsequently the Straus-inspired camperships have consistently underwritten this aspiration to support those in need and bunks full of happy children have benefitted over the years. And the awards have come with only one condition – upon arrival at camp, no child's financial status would be shared with anyone. In other words, every camper would confidently step onto the mountain with equal footing.

Affordability

Having just recently celebrated our 100th anniversary, **keeping camp affordable** remains a prominent part of our mission. And we are very proud of our strong reputation for doing so. We are committed to monitoring every way we can be cost aware, while at the same time providing the **Best in Jewish Camping Experiences**. However, at times, even with our best efforts directed at affordability, social and economic factors can make paying tuition problematic for some members of our camp community. We understand that due to acute or ongoing financial challenges there might still remain a gap between what camp fees are and what some camper families can manage. In those instances, and in order to fill in some of those gaps we are pleased to provide the opportunity to apply for a campership.

General Campership Application Procedures

Like a scholarship, consideration for campership funding requires completing some forms, supplying some supporting documentation and paying attention to some deadlines. And like a scholarship, camperships come with no obligation for repayment. If you are interested in applying for a campership the following list highlights "how to":

- **Camper Registration:** Please complete and submit the camper registration online for Summer 2025, along with the accompanying refundable deposit. Campership applications cannot be reviewed before your camper is registered for the camp session.
- Campership Application Forms, etc.: Please complete and forward the completed Campership Application Form (Summer 2025) as well as all supporting documentation including:
 - o Copies of all 2023/2024 IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040 EZ (all pages)
 - o Copies of all 2023/2024 W-2 forms
 - o Copies of all 2023/2024 1099 forms
 - o Copies of recent paystubs

(all forms will be shredded after your application has been considered, so please send us **only COPIES** of your materials)

- Campership Application Reviews: In most circumstances we are able to complete the campership application review without the need for an interview, so we are pleased to offer a remote review of your materials. This might require some phone communications should we have any need for clarification. Upon completion of the review, you will be notified as soon as possible about the award decision and a payment plan will be coordinated for payment in full.
- **Deadlines:** We aim to provide rolling consideration of all Campership Applications (in most cases we will attempt to review the request as close as possible to the time we receive your completed application). And as you might expect, the earlier we are able to review your application the more flexibility we have in making suitable campership funds available.
 - o The **firm** deadline for Campership Applications for all currently enrolled campers is **December 2, 2024**.
 - o <u>All other reviews</u> will be completed as soon as all camper registration, campership application and supporting materials are received.
